The awful, awkward fun is about to begin.

Here's how to make the game:

- 1: Take this PDF file to a printing facility that won't judge you. Any office supply or copying store that's too big to care should do.
- 2: Print the pages on decent quality card stock – 60 lb. weight or more preferably. Don't worry if it tells you the edges are outside the printable area. The edges are irrelevant.
- 3: If you're feeling splurgy, print them in color, use card stock in the wedding colors (as long as they're nauseating pastels) and/or print the backs of the dark cards dark too, so they're easier to sort. If you're feeling cheap or lazy, just print them in black and white on thick paper using your home computer.
- 4: Cut the cards out along the lines. Be patient and have fortitude. The success of your friend's (or your own) marriage depends on achieving clean edges.
- 5: Take the game to your bachelor party, bachelorette party, bridal shower, groomal reckoning — or for maximum awkwardness, to the wedding itself — in a custom, hand-decorated box made of local organic recycled cardboard, a plastic baggy, or some other receptacle befitting the matrimonial vibe.

PRO TIP: Use a different color card stock for the question cards!

Use the printable card backs on p. 23–24 for extra pizzazz.

HOW TO PLAY:

- Deal about seven light cards to each player – more or less depending on how many players you have.
- Starting with the Betrothed, one player draws a dark card and reads its contents to the group.
- Each of the other players submits face-down to the reader the light card(s) that they believe most truthfully and movingly responds to the question or fills the blanks, and draws another light card.
- The reader shuffles the light cards received, reads the responses aloud, and chooses the light card that he or she loves the most. The person who played that card keeps the dark card.
- Process repeats with the next person.
- The first person to acquire the agreed-upon number of dark cards has the option of stealing the Betrothed's future spouse.
- If the marriage is still on and you're all still friends at the end of this ordeal, everybody wins.

TWO-FERS

Some fill-in-the-blank cards have two blanks. For these, play the card you want read in the first blank face down first, and the card you want in the second blank face down on top of it. The reader should read the bottom card first. Then draw two more cards. (Obviously.)
